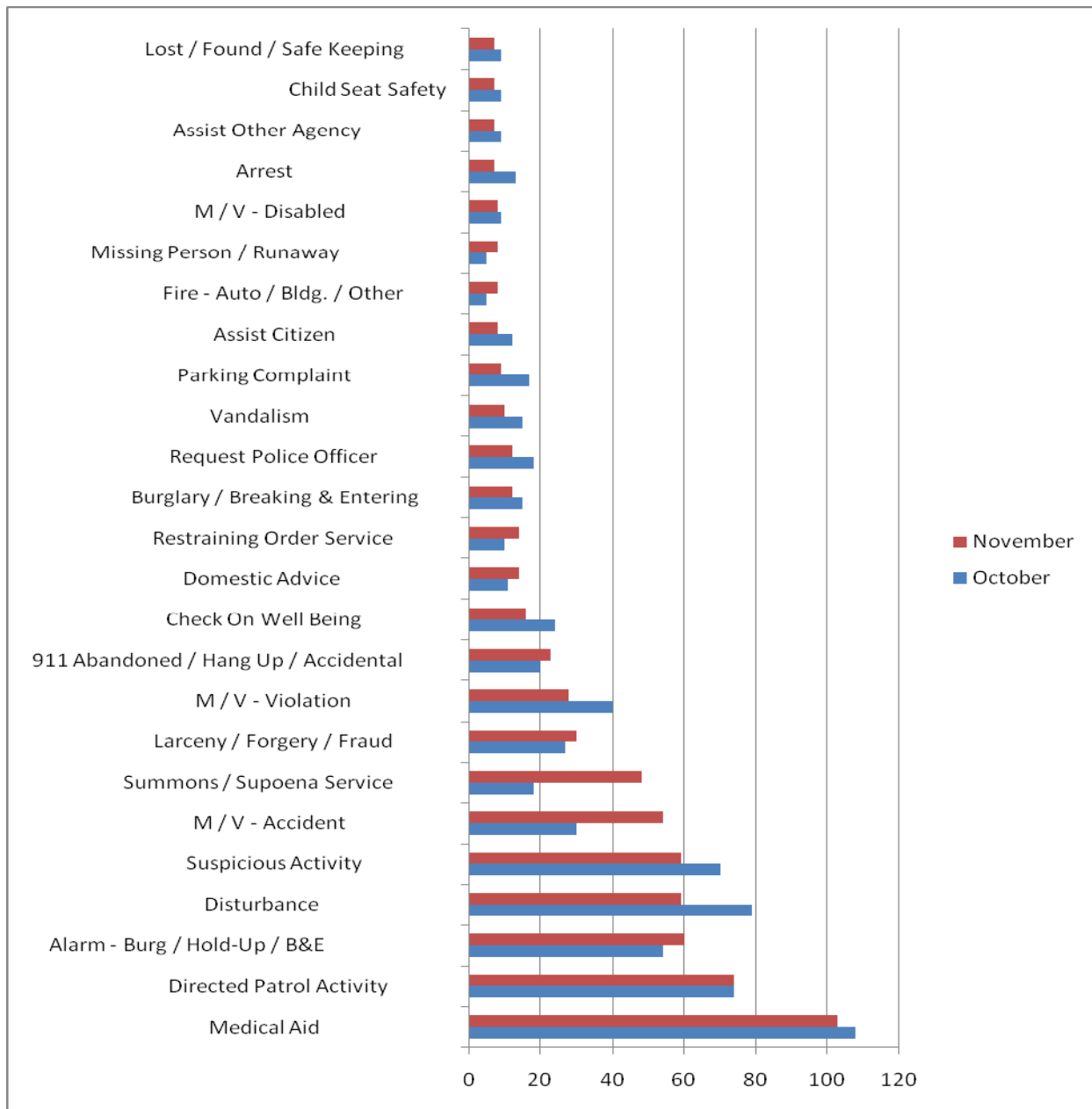

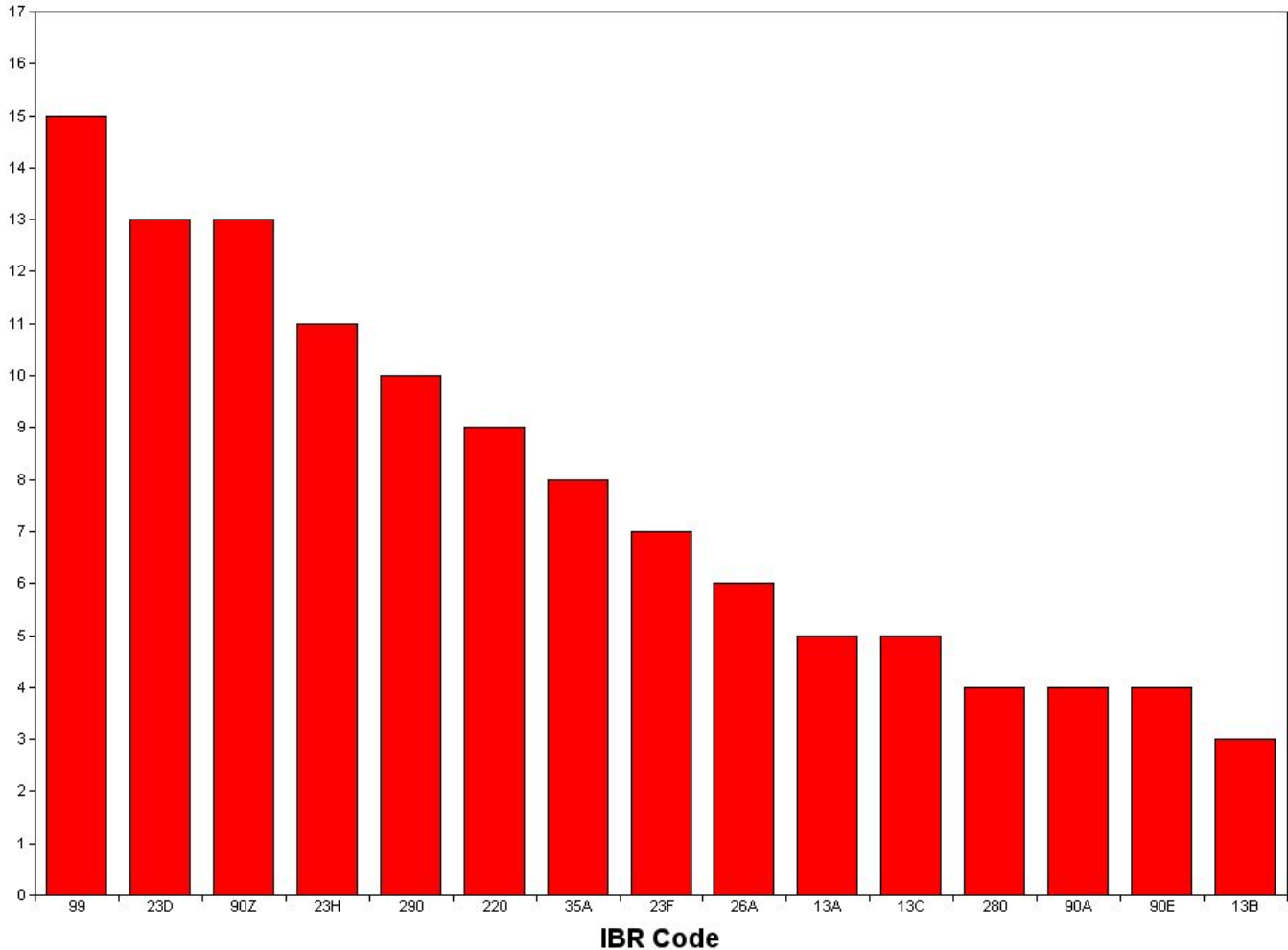

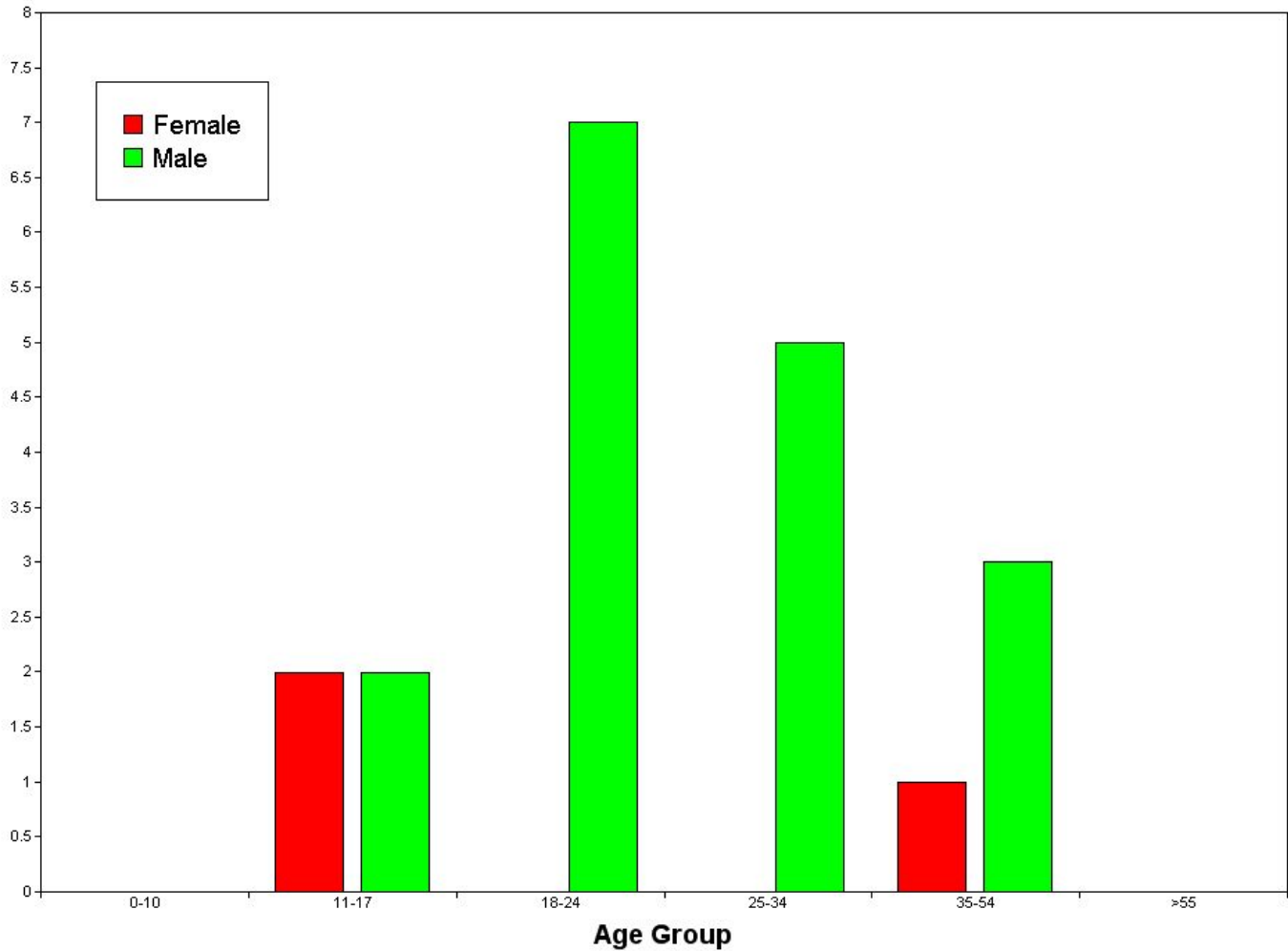

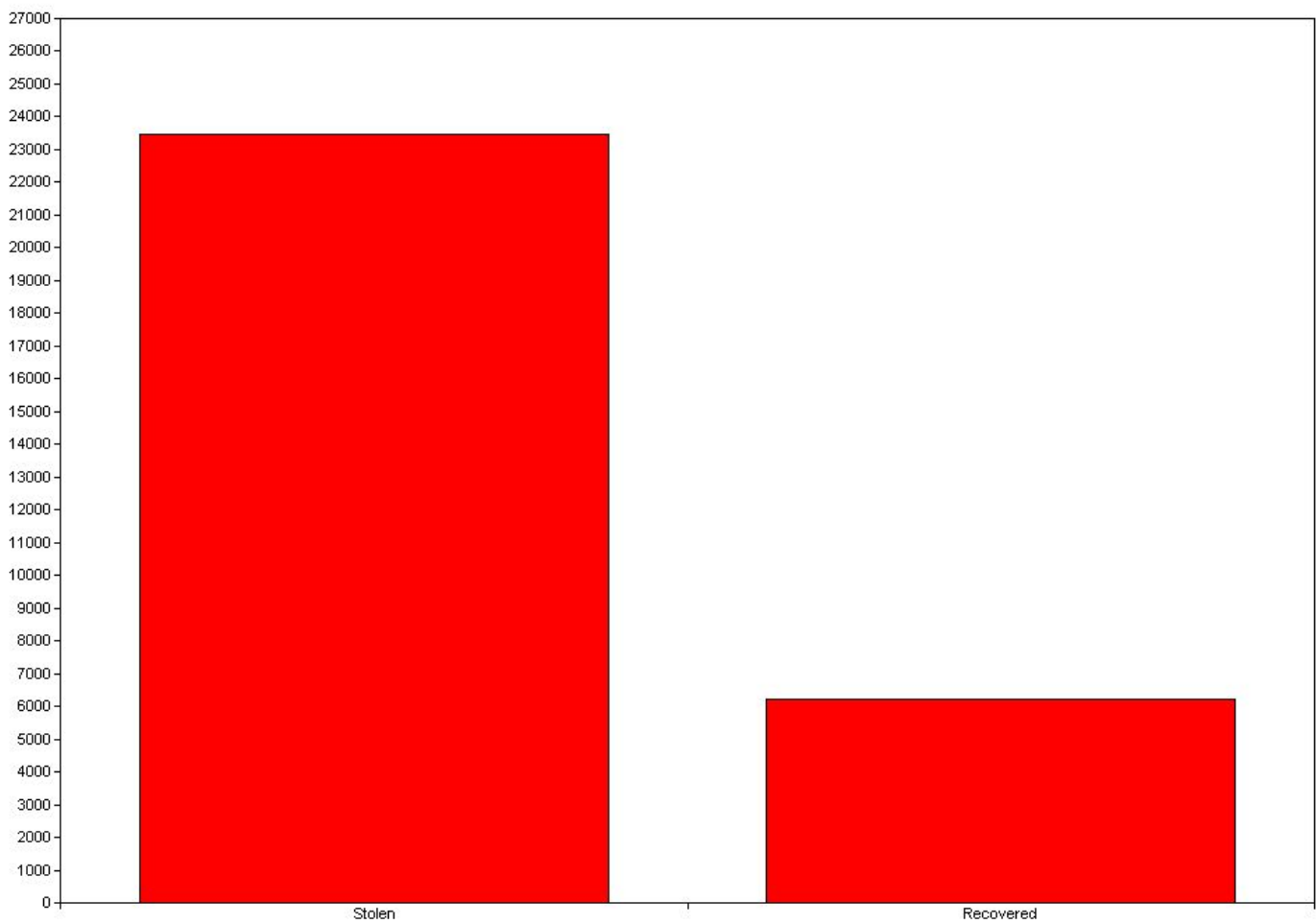

Stolen/Recovered Value



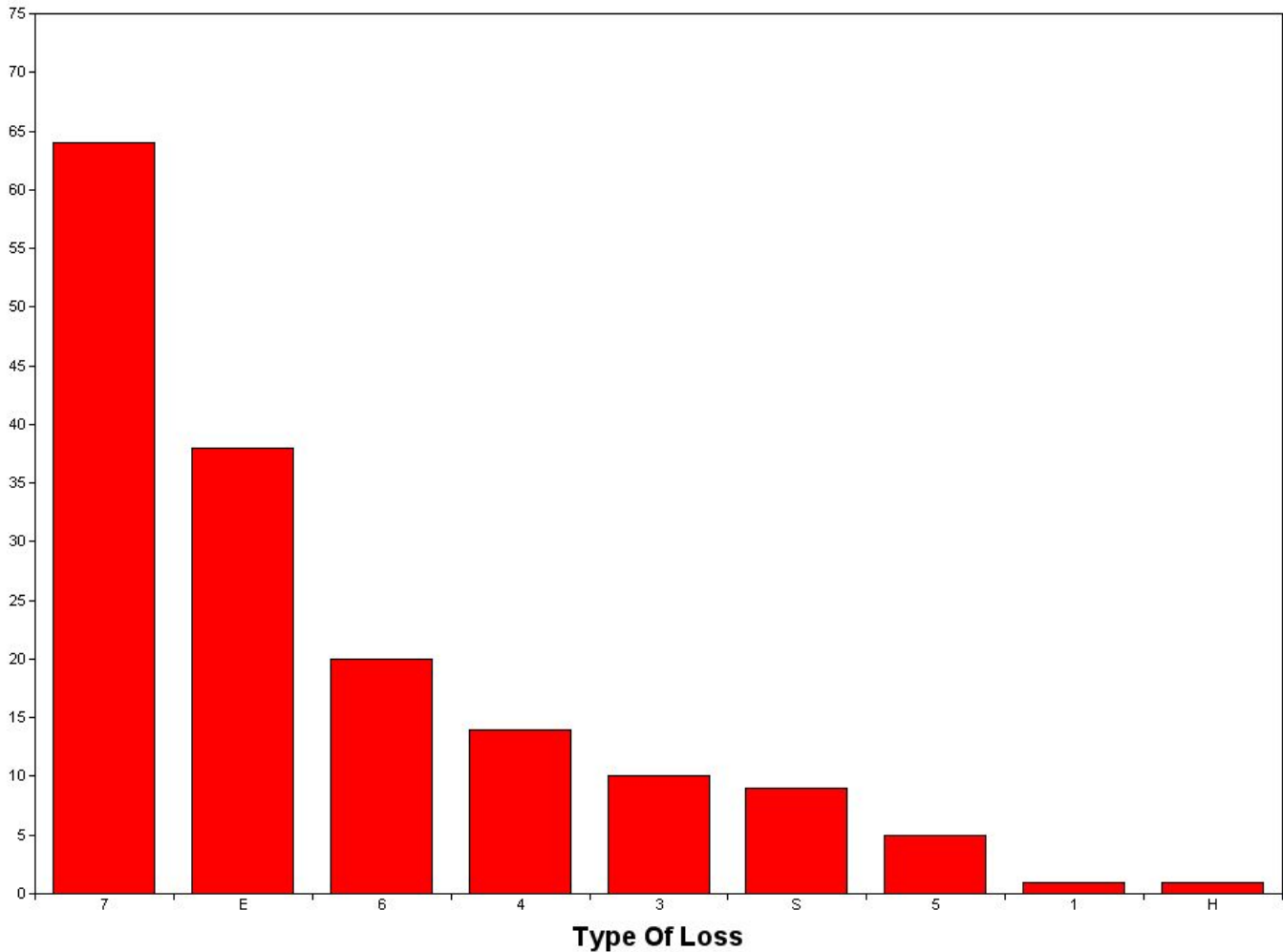
